Please note the clinic will be divided in half based on level. Once the enrollment is complete we can figure out what would be the best place to divide the skaters into groups so that everyone gets the most out of this clinic. We are asking that the skaters have begun their USFS testing. **No LTS for this particular clinic.**

How this will work is: Group 1 will be with Gracie while Group 2 will be with Craig for the first 30 minutes, and then the groups will swap. So each group will receive 30 minutes with Gracie and 30 minutes with Craig. This will happen for the spins, jumps, and skills time slots.

All skaters will be together for the off ice and the Presentation portion of the clinic.

The jump/spin pass will work as follows: Group 1 will be lined up on the blue line with Gracie and Group 2 will be lined up on the other blue line with Craig. Each skater will be allowed to do 1 jump or spin of their choice and get 1 comment from them. Then the groups will swap. In the end 2 elements, 2 comments (1 from Gracie & 1 from Craig).

At the end there will be a brief question and answer session along with photos and autographs.

If skaters register within the first week starting tonight (11/1/22 – 11/8/22), the cost is \$175. If they sign up between 11/9/22 – 11/19/22, the cost increases to \$190.
