The day of the show:

Relax, kick back and enjoy the show! We encourage you to stay for the entire show. Each one of our skaters, young and old work very hard and look forward to our show every year. Please stay and support our local skaters. They love to entertain, and they love to hear all that applause. This is also a wonderful opportunity for all our younger skaters to watch, learn, and become inspired and motivated from our older, experienced skaters.

Each group will have a designated locker room downstairs the day of the show. The locker rooms will be labeled. No fathers will be allowed in the girl's locker rooms, and likewise, no mothers will be allowed in the boy's locker rooms. We ask that you please make sure your skaters have used the restroom before their performance. Once skaters are dressed in their costume, have their skates on, and are ready to go, we ask that the parents leave the locker room. There will not be enough room in the locker rooms the day of the show. You may come pick up your skaters immediately following their performance.

WHEN TO BE IN THE LOCKER ROOM:

1st Half: Should be in their locker rooms by 2:00pm

2nd Half: Should be in the locker rooms at intermission in costume and ready to go

Regarding your costumes: All costumes MUST be turned in at the end of the show, so please be sure to bring a change of clothes. Costumes should be given to the parent in charge of your group so they can make sure all pieces have been turned in.

All skaters are invited to skate in our finale at the end of the show in their costumes. Learn to Skate skaters should please be in your locker rooms at least 4 numbers before the end of the show.

Masks:

Although Cheel Arena and PFSC do not require masks, because our ice show is sanctioned by US Figure Skating masks ARE required. They still have a mask policy in place. Please be sure to share this information with your friends and family.

Video:

The show will be professionally videotaped again this year by Wendy O'Brien from the Video Lab. You should receive the order form via email and we will also have order forms at the rink at dress rehearsal. Form will be on our website and orders will be accepted until Friday, March 18th.
