Each group will have a designated locker room downstairs the day of the show. The locker rooms will be labeled accordingly. There will not be enough room in the locker rooms the day of the show. You may come pick up your skaters immediately following their performance.

All skaters are invited to skate in our finale at the end of the show in their costumes. Learn to Skate skaters should please be in your locker rooms at least 4 numbers before the end of the show.
